All Off-Site ATMs Now Live

In late October 2025, we shared that all 7 17 Credit Union off-site ATMs are officially up and running! Beginning September 16, we installed seven new ATMs and three Personal Teller Machines (PTMs), rolling out two each week through mid-October. By November 1, all upgraded machines, each owned by 7 17 Credit Union, were

Members who were charged **Foreign ATM fees** at non–7 17 ATMs between April 1 and September 16, 2025, will have those fees reversed. These refunds apply only to Foreign ATM fees assessed by 7 17 Credit Union for out-of-network transactions. Refunds can be verified through online or mobile banking or by checking your statement. (Note: Members who already received fee refunds through WOW benefits were not refunded a second time.)

2025 was an unforgettable year for 7 17 Credit Union. It was a year full of growth, connection, and exciting opportunities to better serve our members and our communities. None of it would be possible without you, our members.

We're thrilled to share one of our biggest milestones: our upcoming merger with Geauga Credit Union. This means more ways to serve you, with new branches in Burton and Middlefield and expanded membership into Geauga and Ashtabula counties. We're welcoming an additional 6,500 members to our 7 17 family, giving even more people access to the financial tools and support they need to thrive.

This merger is just the beginning of our \$50 million commitment to Northeast Ohio. In 2026, we'll open new branches in Stow, Streetsboro, and Akron — expanding the credit union movement and bringing 7 17 closer to our 120,000 members across the region. For us, every new branch is more than a location; it's a chance to help people live better lives financially and build stronger communities throughout Northeast Ohio.

But 2025 wasn't just about growth — it was about giving back more value than ever before. We cut fees significantly, ensuring that members keep more of their hard-earned money. We also launched our groundbreaking *Your Keys. No Fees.* mortgage program — designed to make homeownership more affordable for our workplace partners by eliminating unnecessary fees and simplifying the process.

In addition, we introduced our Visa Affinity Card — what we believe is the best credit card in the country. It offers highly competitive rates, a 7.17% APR introductory rate, and no annual fee. Paired with some of the lowest auto loan rates in the state and market-leading Certificate rates, 7 17 members experienced exceptional savings and returns all year long.

Our dedication to the community remained just as strong. Through our Forever Youngstown promotion, we gave back over \$100,000 to support the Youngstown area — a city and community at the heart of our story. We also strengthened our partnership with Youngstown State University, unveiling a co-branded Visa® credit card and supporting YSU's student-athletes in their academic and athletic pursuits.

It's the latest in a host of partnerships supporting non-profits like the Greater Stark County and Warren-Youngstown Urban leagues, and community staples like the RubberDucks and Scrappers. Every partnership reflects our belief that together, we can make our communities stronger, more vibrant, and full of opportunity.

SCAM ALERT: Imposter Scheme

Targets 7 17 Members

7 17 members are being targeted by a growing scam. Scammers will call you, pretending to be from 7 17, often using **spoofed caller ID** to make the call look legitimate. They claim there's a problem with your account and use your fear to gain access to your money.

There has been **no breach of member data at 7 17**. These scammers do not know that you are a member — they simply dial random phone numbers in the area until they reach someone who is. This scam affects many financial institutions.



They often instruct you to move money into a "new, secure" account – but this account is controlled by the scammer. To make the scheme appear more credible, they may introduce a **fake IRS, Social Security, or FBI agent** who claims they need to "secure" your funds.

Then the fake agent demands you send your money to a specific account, buy gift cards or provide personal information.

Once you give them access to your money — it's gone.

If you receive a call like this, **hang up immediately**. Then, call 7 17 directly at **800-775-7741**, or contact the government agency using its official phone number — not one provided by the caller. Remember: No government agency will ever call you demanding money transfers or gift cards. Stay alert!



SavvyMoney Is Getting Savvier

There are upgrades coming to Credit Score, a tool within 7 17 digital banking. We are now offering new tools to support your financial wellness. The Credit Score dashboard will now show suggested offers for solutions to help you with your financial wellness like 717 credit cards, auto loan refinancing and debt consolidation. It's all so you can keep track of your financial health — and get your finances right where you want them.

7 17 is also updating the credit score model in digital banking to better match what we use for most loan approvals. VantageScore 4.0, the most updated Vantage credit score model, uses updated data and analytics to provide a clearer picture of your credit health. When this upgrade occurs, your score might go up or down a bit — that's totally normal. It doesn't mean anything about your credit has suddenly changed.
